The Senior Center, Inc. does not endorse any of the included services.

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Notes on this Guide

Note: Retirement Communities (Independent Living) offer a range of housing options. Retirement communities provide either a purchase or lease option ranging from condominium-style ownership to monthly rental apartments. These communities may offer some services and amenities, such as recreation facilities, meal preparation or congregate meals, housekeeping services, and laundry services. The cost of these services may not be included in the monthly fee. It is best to find out what services are available, and at what cost, before entering a retirement community. Here is a cross section of both low income rental homes and higher priced rentals.

Note: Modified Retirement Communities offer the same services as the Continuing Care Retirement Communities but without the health care guarantee. For example, a modified facility may provide 15 days of nursing care per year. After you use up your 15 days, you must pay a daily charge for the nursing care. In the event you run out of money, the facility is not contractually obligated to provide for your care.

Note: A Continuing Care Retirement Community is a financially self-sufficient residential community for seniors that offers medical and nursing services in addition to independent living. CCRC's differ in the amount of health care they offer their residents. Generally, they provide food, housing, medical services, nursing care, and assisted living for the remainder of the retiree's life. A CCRC charges two fees: a one-time entry fee followed by a monthly maintenance fee.

NOTE: Concerning all nonaffiliated providers (Care Providers, Equipment, Groups, Sources, etc.), the Senior Center is not endorsing our referrals. All information is a resource for our Members and Community.

This center furnishes impaired adults of all ages with therapeutic care including medical management, meals, recreation and socialization. Its facilities include a Healing Arts Garden, Alzheimer's area, beauty parlor and bathing facility.

JABA offers a fun, caring and safe environment for any adult (18 years +) who needs assistance with daily health or personal care activities. Participants — at both our Hillsdale and Louisa locations choose from a variety of social and recreational programs. We specialize in the care of adults with dementia.

Much like the activities at our area Community Centers, which are best suited independent adults to who seek companionship, we sing, move to music, walk, garden, play bingo and word games, dance, play balloon ball, and arrange flowers. Young children from local schools join center members in activities, which makes it fun for everyone. Some members choose to sit quietly with a friend, or read and discuss current events. Every day, a hot, fresh lunch — incorporating local foods whenever possible — and two healthy snacks are served. Special diet supplements are always available.

Our goal is to keep families together and to prevent or delay institutionalization. Guided by the specific needs of a personalized care plan, JABA nurses monitor health, administer medication, and oversee specialized Alzheimer's and dementia care. JAUNT and other specialized transit come directly to our doors. JABA accepts Medicaid, private, long-term care insurance, veteran benefits and private pay. Scholarships are available. The Center receives scholarship support from local governments and individual donors for this program.

- Explain how you got into your situation/what caused it.
- Explain what steps you have taken to improve your situation.
- Explain what money of yours will be contributed to the need.

You should bring:

- All documents verifying your situation (such as disconnection and eviction notices)
- A list of your monthly expenses, pay stubs or other income verification
- Picture identification

For Social Services benefits, be prepared to provide:

- · Pay stubs or other income verification
- Utility bills
- Copy of lease/rental agreement
- Birth certificate/verification
- · Positive identification, i.e. Social Security card
